POSSESSIVE 'S STRUCTURE:
WHOSE + `S + WHAT(OBJECT)

JOHN'S BOOK

1. NAMES THAT FINISH WITH “S” ADD `S.

- EXAMPLE:

- CHARLES`S HOUSE



2. ADVERBS OF TIME ADD `S: SAYS WHEN IT HAPPENS

- YESTERDAY
- NOW
- LAST YEAR
- LATER
- TODAY
- TOMORROW
