Discussions and presentations will be centered on the reading and development of students' materials and relevant workshops given for the teacher. The socialization of cultural aspects will enrich the speaking activities, encouraging to the students to combine the theory and practice.

FORMATIVE: By course work which is mainly task-based with group and individual instructions. Participants are expected to undertake a wide ranging program of learning tasks which will provide them with opportunities to demonstrate their performance and achievement. Also, the teacher will support the way the students' progress in class to help them overcome their difficulties individually.

SUMMATIVE: The students will take two partials and a final exam, besides the other activities they will perform in classes.
